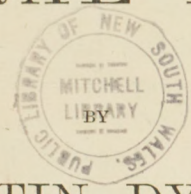

## P R E F A C E .

---

THIS work was given to the Victoria and Tasmania Conference as a Jubilee Volume, but subsequently the compiler of it received permission to complete, print, and publish it on his own responsibility. It comprises the names of our ministers in the Australasian Wesleyan Methodist Church from the beginning, and brings down the appointments to the year 1889. It also indicates the principal offices which each minister has held from the Conferences. Absolute accuracy is scarcely expected, but the numerous names and dates have been taken with care from the minutes of the several Conferences, which should be models of accuracy, and then sent and submitted to the ministers themselves for their own correction and approval. Some of them did not return their lists so corrected and approved, which is to be much regretted. *Q* follows their names. But we hope these brethren will kindly overlook and not complain of any inaccuracies in their records.

Having put the work thus to the best possible test, it is now offered with the hope that such an Index will meet a want among us, and be another small withe to bind our Colonial Conferences together. If it be favourably received, and without financial loss, it will, we hope, be followed by a Companion Index of Circuits, showing the length of time they have kept their ministers.

The compiler very thankfully acknowledges the valued assistance of many of our ministers in all the colonies, and their genial sympathy, which have greatly facilitated this work. He has done what was considered necessary to make it as complete as possible, and a reliable book of reference, and now hopes that it will become valuable and useful beyond its moderate claim and cost.
