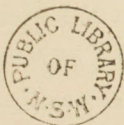

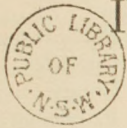
knowledge of colonial thoroughbreds has been of paramount service in collating the following pages.

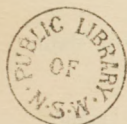

PILOT,

Bred by Mr. W. M. ALEXANDER, in 1840, got by Sheet Anchor ;—his dam, Theresa, by The Moslem, g d Wilful, by Waxy, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 5, p. 308.) Dead.

PLOVER,

By Æther ;—his dam, Medusa, by Mæonides (imported), g d by Whisker (imported). Æther, by Æther (imported) ;—his dam by Whisker (imported), g d by Skeleton (imported), g g d by Bay Camerton (imported). Is the property of Mr. John Johnston.

PUNJAUB,

Bred by Mr. COOKSON, in 1842, got by Muley Moloch ;—his dam, Deuce, by Perion, g d Raffle, by Lottery, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 5, p. 83.) Dead.

REMBRANDT,

Bred in Tasmania, got by Rubens (imported) ;—his dam, Madame Lister (imported). Was imported to Victoria by Mr. J. N. M'Leod. Rembrandt was killed by a snake.

RICHVIEW,

Bred by Lord HOWTH, in 1855, got by Bandy Boy ;—his dam, Gayfield, by Lanercost, g d Camelia, by Voltaire, g g d Camelina (sister to Camel), &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 8, p. 171.) Was imported to Victoria, in 1858, by Mr. James Purves. Is the property of Mr. H. Phillips.

ROBIN HOOD,

Bred by Mr. FRANCIS HENTY, got by Little John (imported);—his dam, Octavia (imported), by Whalebone, g d Blacking, by Octavius, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 3, p. 39.)

ROMEO,

Bred by Mr. ORMSBY GORE, in 1829, got by Partisan;—his dam, Vice, by Oiseau, g d Wire (sister to Whisker), by Waxy, g g d Penelope, by Trumpeter, g g g d Prunella, by Highflyer. (See General Stud Book, vol. 3, p. 540, in which it states that Romeo was sent to Van Diemen's Land.) Dead.

ROMULUS,

Bred in New South Wales, got by Cap-a-pie (imported);—his dam, Ithica, by Dover (imported). (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 258), g d Penelope (imported), (bred by Lord Exeter in 1827,) by Phantom.

RORY O'MORE,

Bred in Ireland, got by Irish Birdcatcher;—his dam, by Drone, g d Mary Anne, by Waxy Pope, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 578.) Was imported to Victoria by Mr. W. P. Greene. Dead.

ROYAL WILLIAM,

Bred by Mr. W. EDWARDS, in 1831, got by Royal Oak;—his dam, Princess Royal, by Middleton, g d by Orville, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 377.) Dead.

SARAWAK,

Bred in Tasmania, in 1850, got by Jersey (imported);—his dam, Fairy Queen, by Mozart, g d Fairy (imported to Van Diemen's Land in '31, and said to be by Phantom.)

SATELLITE,

Imported to New South Wales, from Bombay, by Sir Thomas Brisbane, for the Government, about 1824. Dead.

SIR HERCULES,

Bred by Mr. C. SMITH, in New South Wales, got by Cap-a-pie (imported);—his dam, Paraguay (imported), by Sir Hercules, g d Paradigm, by Partisan, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 346.)

SNOOZER,

Bred by Mr. BILLINGTON, in 1837, got by Muley;—his dam, Bequest, by Election, g d Legacy, by Beningbrough, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 40.)

STEELTRAP,

Bred by Mr. THORNHILL, in 1815, got by Scud;—his dam, Prophetess, by Sorcerer, g d Pamela, by Whiskey, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 2, p. 227.) Was imported to New South Wales in 1823. Dead.

ST. GEORGE,

Bred in 1835, got by Seagrave;—his dam, by Governor, g d Anticipation, by Beningbrough, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 3, p. 7.) Dead.

ST. JOHN,

Bred by Mr. J. BRISKHAM, in 1834, got by St. Nicholas;—his dam, Thunderbolt mare, g d by Precipitate, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 458.) Was imported to Sydney in 1836.

ST. PATRICK,

Bred in Tasmania, in 1847, got by Lucifer (imported);—his dam by Peter Fin (imported). Was imported to Victoria in 1855. Is the property of Mr. Wright.

TARTAR,

By Peter Fin (imported);—his dam, Matilda, by Bolivar (imported), g d Agnes, by Hector (imported). Dead.

THE PREMIER,

Bred by Mr. J. R. MOSTYN, in 1843, got by Tory Boy;—his dam, Baroness, by Leopold, g d The Duchess, by Cardinal York, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 6, p. 23.) Was imported in 1849. Is the property of Messrs. Macknight and Irvine.

THE THAMES,

Bred in 1856, got by Kingston;—his dam by Heron, g d by Muley, g g d Sister to Pope, &c. Was imported in 1859. Is the property of Messrs. Greene and Macartney.

TOSS,

Bred by Mr. CLIFTON, in 1822, got by Bourbon;—his dam, Gohanna mare, g d Fraxinella, by Trentham, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 3, p. 148.) Was imported to New South Wales, by Messrs. Scott, in 1828. Dead.

TOUCHIT,

Bred by Major GEO. BROWN, in 1848, got by Ithuriel;—his dam, Actual, by Actæon, g d Jubilee, by Catton, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 8, p. 3.) Was imported to Victoria, from Tasmania, in 1858.

TRANBY,

Bred by Mr. NELSON LAWSON, got by Operator (imported);—his dam, Nell Gwynne, by Chancellor, g d Silvertail (imported to New South Wales by Mr. Charles Smith).

TRAVELLER,

By Bay Camerton (imported);—his dam, by Steeltrap (imported), g d by Hector (imported to New South Wales, about 1804;—was an Indian stud-bred horse).

TROS,

Bred by Lord ALBEMARLE, in 1836, got by Priam;—his dam, Ally, by Partisan, g d Jest, by Waxy, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 12.) Tros was sold to Mr. Kater, and imported to New South Wales in 1839. Dead.

VAGABOND,

Bred by Mr. YATES, in 1829, got by Cain;—his dam, Gabrielle, by Partisan, g d Coquette, by Dick Andrews, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 176.) Dead.

VAN TROMP,

Bred by Mr. G. ROUSE, in New South Wales, got by St. John (imported);—his dam, Crazy Jane, by Emigrant (imported), g d Stella, by Peter Fin (imported), g g d Spaewife (imported), &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 111.) Was imported to Victoria, by Mr. E. Crooke, in 1853. Is the property of Mr. Crooke.

WALRUS,

Bred by the AUSTRALIAN AGRICULTURAL COMPANY, in New South Wales, got by Grampus (imported), by Whalebone (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 388);—his dam, Australia (imported), by Clavileno, g d by Don Cossack, g g d Helen, by Whiskey. (See General Stud Book, vol. 2, p. 178.) Dead.

WANDERER,

Bred by Lord EGREMONT, in 1826, got by Wanderer;—his dam, Ogress, by Octavius, g d Thalestris, by Alexander, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 3, p. 280.) Was imported to the Swan River by Mr. Henty. Dead.

WARHAWK,

Bred by Mr. BOUVERIE, in 1848, got by Epirus;—his dam, Valentine, by Voltaire, g d Fisher Lass, by Osmond, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 7, p. 366.) Was imported by Mr. H. N. Simson, in 1854. Is the property of Messrs. Simson and Row.

WARWICK,

Bred by Mr. HOLLOWAY, in 1847, got by Sir Isaac;—his dam, Mystery, by Phantom, g d Charming Molly, by Rubens, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 7, p. 269.) Was imported to New South Wales, by Messrs. Tait and Jenner, in 1856.

WAVERLEY,

Bred in New South Wales, got by St. George (imported);—his dam, Splendor (imported), by Emancipation, &c. (See General Stud Book, vol. 4, p. 460.) Was imported to Victoria in 1859. Is the property of Mr. Barber.

WHISKER,

Imported to New South Wales, when a yearling, by Mr. Henry Bayley. His pedigree is unknown, but from his running and stock, must have been a horse of very high character. Dead.

WOLLATON,

Bred by Sir TATTON SYKES, in 1850, got by The Caster;—his dam by Bay Middleton, g d by Comus, g g d Emma, by Don Cossack. (See General Stud Book, vol. 8, p. 34.) Was imported by Mr. James Purves in 1858. Is the property of the Government.
